



Utility Location Manager

Summary:

After initial training is completed, this working manager is responsible for supervising a field crew of 2 to 6 members to oversee their daily tasks. The ULM has complete responsibility for staging the quality of the field effort: train the field crew, delegate work, assign work areas, review and check the crew's quality of work and make sure the standard operating procedures are followed. The ULM will also oversee projects where crew members are using electronic equipment to locate and mark gas, water, sewer, phone, power, and CATC lines. Monday - Friday travel depending on where the work is located.

Education:

High School Education or GED is preferred

Required Skills/Experience:

- Every candidate/employee must have their own form of transportation to and from the office every day.

- Must be able to pass a pre-employment drug test.
- Must have management/supervisory experience in: Leading teams, managing crew members, and subcontractors.
